Hello Cascade Residents, it is that time of the year for another newsletter installment. This time I wanted to take some time to discuss how to report incidents or issues that are happening around the village. First if you have an emergency or need the situation addressed now, please call 911 (EMERGENCIES ONLY) or 920-459-3112 for non-emergencies.

If the concern or issue can wait, we at the Cascade Police Department would love to help you out. You can call and leave a voicemail message at 920-838-4311 or send me an email at [cascadechief@cascafedep.onmicrosoft.com](mailto:cascadechief@cascafedep.onmicrosoft.com). The officers check the voicemail each time they are out and will get back with you, if it is reasonable hour or you tell when is a good time to make contact with you. If you send me an email, I will be able to get a response to you about when an officer or myself would be available to address the concern or issue.

Are you able to stay anonymous, well that would really depend on the issue or concern that you express. If you would call in a barking dog and wanted to stay anonymous, we would check the area and if the dog is no longer barking, we would not be able to do anything. If you made the complaint official and left your name, we would check to see if it is occurring, and then make contact and take the appropriate action even if it is no longer occurring.

Hopefully in the next newsletter I will be able to speak more about a new feature that we are looking to deploy for the Police Department that will give better access to reporting concerns or issues, while at the same time possibly giving you as residents an idea of some of things that are happening throughout the village from our perspective.

The Utility Board has approved the acceptance of credit cards for payment of utility bills!

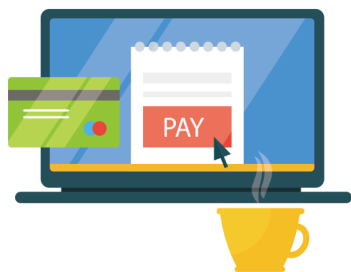
Using UB-Pay customers are able to create an online account to view bills and pay your bill online with a credit card or e-check.

2022 Elections	
Partisan Primary	August 9th, 2022
General Election	November 8th, 2022

Photo ID laws are still in effect, so please be sure to bring your approved photo ID to the polls! The polls are open from 7am-8pm on election day!

**ABSENTEE VOTERS**, keep in mind the new Waukesha County Circuit Court Order that is in effect and states that according to Statutes the only lawful methods for casting an absentee ballot are for the elector to either (1) place the envelope containing the ballot in the mail or (2) for the elector to deliver the ballot in person to the municipal clerk.

**\*\*Going forward please DO NOT use the drop box at the Village hall to return your ballot.\*\***

**\*\*\*This also means that spouses are not able to hand deliver ballots for each other.\*\*\***

**PARTISAN PRIMARY, AUGUST 9TH**, At a partisan primary, you may only vote for candidates in **ONE** political party. This means you must choose **one** political party in which you will vote, and only vote for individual candidates within that party.

## Yard Waste Information

Since summer is here and everyone is working hard to keep their properties looking great, this is a good time to go over criteria for yard waste and a few changes to our operations.

**Brush-** must have all cut ends facing the road. There may be NO vines or weeds mixed into it. If you need to rake it up it must be in some type of container for pickup. Piles of brush may not exceed 4 ft high by 4 ft wide. If you are cutting down a tree, YOU are responsible for removing all debris.

**Bags-** must be under 40lbs.

**NEW-** the new brush pile is located near Memorial Park on the east side of the river. Only yard waste (brush, leaves, grasses) is allowed. Please do not leave furniture, lumber, building materials or cardboard. If you bring your bagged waste to the pile, they must be opened and dumped. There is a blue recycling bin to dispose of the bags.
