Hello Village Residents,

As part of the annual newsletter, I wanted to direct everyone's attention to our newer website to file complaints and other interests.

- Go to villageofcascadewi.gov
- 2. Navigate to "Government" tab, then "Cascade Police Department"
- 3. The second link down is "Cascade Police Department—City Protect"

When you click on the link, you should see a page similar to the one in this article. From this page, you can file a police report, submit a tip for a crime that occurred, request non-emergency help, register cameras or request records. The crime information and crime map are still a work in progress and we hope to go live soon. What is neat about this website is that it works closely with our records management system, so when you file a report and if you attach photos or videos, they get attached to the call right away. This site allows us to utilize your smart doorbells that are

capturing towards the roadif you register them. If we are investigating something in the area, we would get an alert and then reach out to see if you recorded any events we are investigating. We have already had multiple cameras listed. When you have time take a look at the website. Please enjoy summer and we hope to see you supporting the Fire Department at their annual picnic in August.
